Choose earthy tones for subtlety or make a splash with bright circles on a contrasting background.

## SUPPLIES AND CUTTING

### Blue fabric

Cut 1 square 13" × 13". Trim to 12½" × 12½" after appliqué.

### Green fabric scraps for appliqué

### Paper-backed fusible web

## HOW-TO

Template patterns are on page 216.

1. Trace the circles as follows onto the paper side of the fusible web:

Trace 2 circles using Template A.

Trace 3 circles using Template B.

Trace 3 circles using Template C.

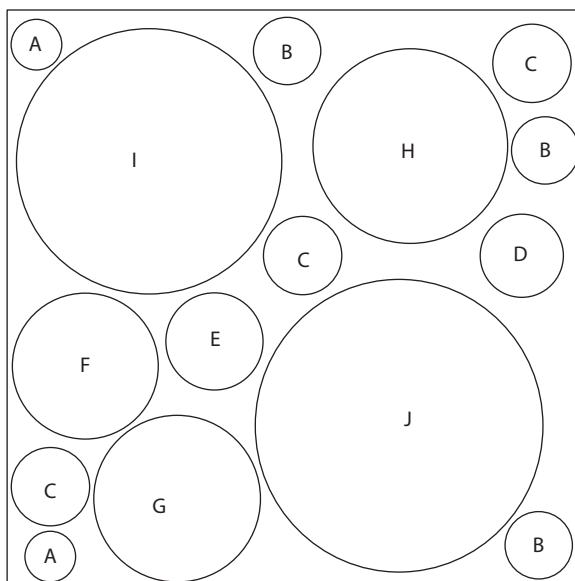
Trace 1 circle each using Templates D, E, F, G, H, I, and J.

2. Cut out the circles from the fusible web ¼" outside the drawn lines.

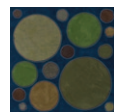
3. Iron the cut-out circles of fusible web (following the manufacturer's instructions) onto the wrong side of the appliqué fabrics. Cut out the fabric circles on the drawn lines and peel off the backing paper.

4. Fuse the circles to the background fabric. Refer to the layout diagram for placement.

5. Stitch around the raw edges of the circles with a small zigzag stitch. Trim the block to 12½" × 12½".
